TEATRO CÍRCULO PREMIERES THE GOLDEN AGE CLASSIC EL ALCALDE DE ZALAMEA FROM NOVEMBER 8 TO 24, 2024



When a father's love meets military abuse, justice becomes a deadly weapon.



New York, NY October 8, 2024 - **Teatro Círculo**, one of New York City's leading Spanish-language theater companies, continues the celebration of its 30th anniversary with the staging of the Golden Age Classic *El alcalde de Zalamea* (The Mayor of Zalamea) by **Pedro Calderón de la Barca**, under the direction of **Daniel Alonso de Santos** and Verse Direction by **Karmele Aranburu**. The performances, in Spanish language with overtitles in English, are scheduled to run from **November 8th to November 24th**, **2024** at Teatro Círculo on 64 East 4th Street, New York.

Calderon's classic explores the moral challenges of a wealthy peasant, Pedro Crespo, played by **Gerardo Gudiño**, whose daughter, Isabel played by **Sandra Gumuzzio**, is attacked by a Captain of the Spanish Army. When Pedro Crespo is elected the Mayor of Zalamea, he finds himself in a position of power, able to avenge his daughter.

The show's director, **Daniel Alonso de Santos**, comments: "The Mayor of Zalamea, is a creative process that presents a body of work from the Golden Age set in Puerto Rico at the beginning of the 20th century during the US Army invasion of the island in 1898. In *El alcalde de Zalamea*, (The Mayor of Zalamea) we make reference to how an army can be destructive and how it can also be an army of salvation, among many other relevant themes."

Teatro Círculo's Founding Artistic Director, **José Cheo Oliveras**, says: "For *El alcalde de Zalamea*, we brought director Daniel Alonso from Spain, and we have been rehearsing all of August, in 7-hours a day rehearsal, Monday to Friday, and we are working hard to bring all the elements together with a great cast and production team".
